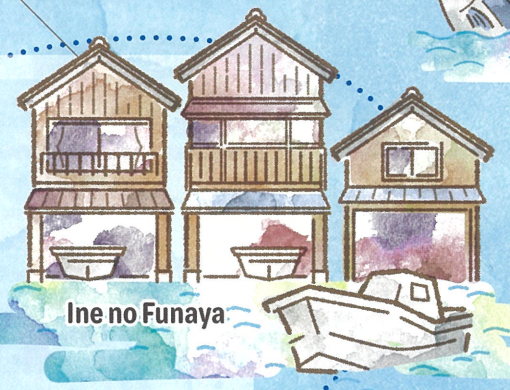

What are Funaya (Boat Houses)?

舟屋
The first floor functions as a boat garage while the second floor serves as living quarters. About 230 funaya boat houses line the 5 km shoreline of Ine Bay.

The unique scenery and simple lives of the residents led the Ine boat houses to be designated as a Preservation District for Groups of Historic Buildings. Ine village has also been recognized as one of Japan's most beautiful villages for the same reasons. People mainly live in the main building on the opposite side of the street from the sea and boat houses (there are also instances when the main building is located beside the sea). The fishing centered live styles of the residents continue to be inherited today.
