## Enjoy Funaya in the sea!! Ine Bay Boat Tour

Funaya, the boat houses, are unique buildings, standing along the Ine bay coast line. The first floor of Funaya is used as a boat garage and a workspace for fisherman. The second floor is used as a living space. There are about 230 Funayas around Ine bay. The oldest Funaya have existed since the 1700s. In 2005, the Funaya area became a Nationally-selected Preservation District for Groups of Historic Buildings.
