


Ine Town MAP

Kyogamisaki Lighthouse
It stands at 148m above sea level on the hillside of Kyogamisaki. It is also a radio lighthouse and tells ships the direction and distance of the cape.

Distance from Ine Tourist Information
 ...About 4.7km (10 min by Car) ...>Tomari Beach

Sodeshi Rice Terrace
About 400 terraced rice fields overlook the Sea of Japan between steep mountains and the sea. The beautiful scenery of the sea, villages, and terraced rice fields has been certified as one of the 100 best Japanese terraced rice fields.

Kamanyu fisheries "Gyoko Meshi"
The "Gyoko Meshi", where you can enjoy seasonal fresh fish caught in the morning while gazing out at the sea!

Nunobiki Falls
It is called Nunobiki Falls because the water that falls from the summit looks like a white cloth has been dropped. It is a rare waterfall that can only be seen after rain or when the amount of water is abundant during the snowmelt season.

Honjohama Beach
A beach located right next to Urashima Shrine. It is said that the "Tokoyo Beach" that appears in the legend of Urashima Taro refers to Honjo Beach.

Historic Site of Japan Heritage "Tango Daibutsu"
During the Taisho era, employees of silk mills who went out to see the sights of Tokyo fell ill with the Spanish flu, and many died after returning home. Daibustu statue was erected in memory of him.

Urashima Shrine
This shrine is the birthplace of Urashima Taro and is also called Urashima Shrine or Ura Shrine. The oldest official history in Japan, "Nihon Shoki," describes the local legend of Urashima, and the tradition is still passed down in this area.

Tomari Beach
Beach with gentle waves. It is a popular spot where you can relax and play with your children.

Townscape of Funaya
About 230 funaya houses are lined up along Ine. It has also been designated as an Important Preservation District for Groups of Traditional Buildings.

Roadside Station Funaya no Sato Ine
A roadside station on a hill overlooking Ine Bay. Delicious fresh fish dishes such as kaisendon (seafood rice bowl) and yellowtail shabu (buri shabu) available only in winter!

Ine Bay Cruise Ferry
It takes about 30 minutes to travel around Ine Bay. Please enjoy the scenery of the funaya that has walked with the sea.
